

ABOUT THE PROJECT

International Training Course on enhancing emotional awareness through creative expression.

The language of art speaks to us in ways that words cannot. Therefore, it's a language that can be used as a means of connecting what is inside us with outer reality. It can be a tool for expressing our emotions, understanding better the world within us, and transforming this inner invisible energy into something positive and tangible. The project "Inner Bridge" is based on the idea that the creative process is healing and supports growth, self-expression, emotional intelligence, and transformation. We will have a chance to use techniques inspired by Art Therapy including dance, movement, painting, poetry in a search of understanding better who we are, finding the best ways of expressing our inner self, and building bridges with the outer world.

The aim of the project is to create an opportunity for youth workers to learn how to enhance emotional intelligence through the creative process of raising self-awareness and self-expression.



THE PROGRAM

The program of the course is designed as a process of connecting with our body and emotions and bringing it towards natural authentic expression. The activities will be enwrapped in reflection over the concept of creativity and will create space for the participants to share and deepen their understanding over the creative process. In particular we will use:

- Art. Therapy
 - Creative Movement
 - Improvisation
 - Music, Dance, Theatre
 - Contact Improvisation

The evening programme will be shaped together with the participants bringing even more creativity and playfulness.



This project is designed for youth workers - people who are directly or indirectly involved in youth work, and are over 18 years old. It is important that the participants have the possibility to organise a little workshops or activity with their target groups after completing the course, which means it's essential that they work with young people.

The whole project involves online preparation (readings and some small tasks), 6-day training course with full presence and the documentation from the follow-up activity. We are hence looking for participants who are ready to get involved in the whole process and are willing to learn and share their personal perspectives and points of view. Participants will be invited to explore their inner worlds of emotions, beliefs and thoughts and express them through different means of art.

We strive to be as inclusive as possible and will make every attempt to accommodate those who approach us with special needs.

Participants will be asked to pay a participation fee of 60 euros that will be deducted from your travel reimbursement. Please remember that taxi and business class flight tickets will not be reimbursed, only the economy class flight tickets, train tickets and bus tickets will be reimbursed. The reimbursement of the travel costs will be done in EURO, regardless of the currency indicated on the tickets, receipts or invoices. We will organize a bus that will take the participants from Warsaw to the venue and the same process will be arranged on the way back. Please look for the flights to Warsaw and send us your preferable option, before buying the ticket. The money you will spend to get to Warsaw will be reimbursed after the compilation of final evaluation, mobility tool and sending all original tickets and invoices. Before buying any tickets please, check with us if they will be refundable.

As You know, the current situation with worldwide pandemic makes our meeting a bit more difficult.

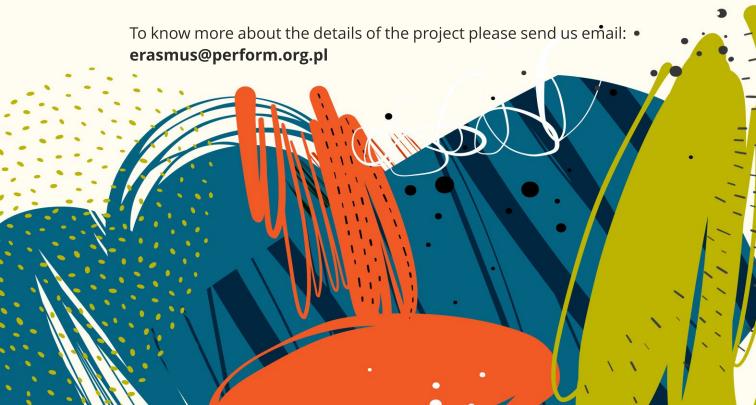
